

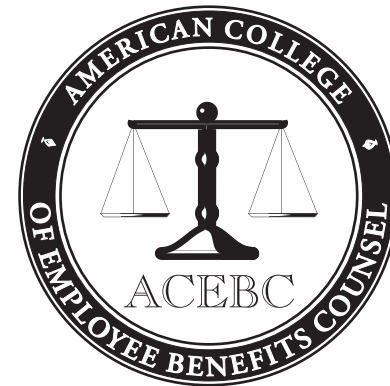
## **About the College**
